Epson T5270d plotter & scanner:



The Epson SureColor T5270D is a dual roll plotter printer and copier with a multifunction scanner.

Students will be able to receive proof-of-concept or draft quality large format prints at a reasonable price.

Prints from this plotter are *not* considered final, production prints. Paper and print quality are suitable only for draft printing.

The T5270D can print or copy up to 35.76" wide. In addition, the T5270D can scan up to 36" wide and up to 96" in length.

General Information:

Original files to be copied or scanned must be a mim. size of 12"x18".

A USB drive must be dropped off with materials to be scanned. Files will be put into a **Scan Me** folder on the provided USB drive. If using an IC Fish Drive, IC Techs will place scanned images in a **Scan Me** folder with your name.

Scanned images will only remain on IC servers for three (3) weeks.

Scanned images will be named:
2016-month-date-IC-lastname-widthlength-resolution.pdf/.jpg.

IC Techs will copy or scan images "as is". Students will be responsible for resizing or color correcting of each file.

Material to be copied or scanned must be submitted either rolled or wrapped in plastic.

Only paper like materials will be accepted. Original material must be clean and free of dust, tears, and staples.

Standard turnaround time for the plotter/scanning process is between 1-2 hours. Please be aware during midterms and finals, turnaround times will increase up to 24 hours.
