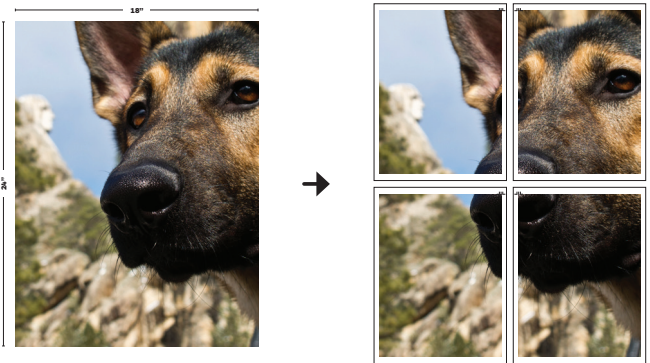


QUICK TIPS

Preparing your file to tile:

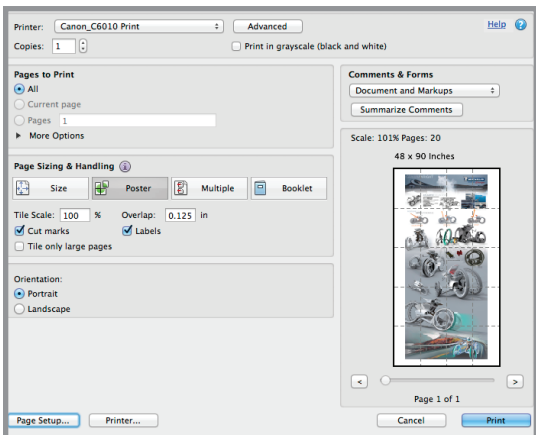
The IC can print or tile a large format document by splitting the page across multiple sheets of paper.

Tiled print requests must be submitted to the IC as a high resolution .jpg file. Techs will convert all .jpgs to the correct PDF file format.



By default, the IC will print all tile jobs using the following specifications:

- 12"x18" Hammermill Card Stock
- Tile Scale: 100%
- 0.125" Overlap
- Cut marks
- Auto Rotate (in Page Setup menu)

Common tile page amounts (12"x18" sheets):

- 18"x24" = 4 sheets
- 24"x36" = 8 sheets
- 33"x68" = 12 sheets
- 37"x84" = 20 sheets
- 42"x200" = 48 sheets
- 55"x170" = 50 sheets

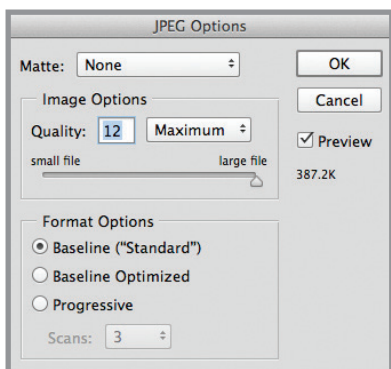
Preparing your file to tile:

For the best results, try the following options in Photoshop:

File > Save As

Format > JPEG

Increase Quality to 12 (large file/maximum)

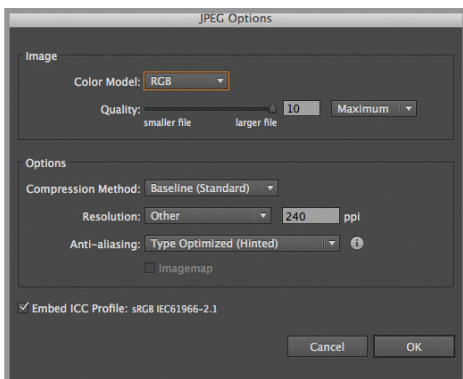


For the best results, try the following options in Illustrator:

File > Export

Format > JPEG (jpg)

Increase Quality to 10 (large file/maximum)
